Brief description of the programme

World Environment Day was celebrated by Gargaon College NSS Unit in collaboration with Social Forestry Department of Nazira Range; Sub-Divisional administration, Nazira and Municipality Board, Nazira Town on 5th June 2019. All the volunteers drove a cleanliness drive in the college campus and also in the nearby areas. After that all volunteers participated in a plantation of Nahor (Ironwood) saplings in the college campus in collaboration with Social Forestry Department of Nazira Range. After the plantation programme, the NSS Unit organized an awareness programme on “Clean and Green Mission” in Nazira Town collaboration with Sub-Divisional administration, Nazira. All volunteers distributed leaflet among all businessmen in Nazira Town and tried to create awareness on transforming Nazira Town to a clean and green town.

All volunteers requested all the shopkeepers to keep at least two plants in tubs and two dustbins (Green and Blue colour) in front of their shops. All volunteers tried to spread this message among all shopkeepers of Nazira Town.
