GARGAON, July 6: The Department of English, Gargaon College, in collaboration with IQAC, Gargaon College, successfully organised a national webinar on the topic "Trends in Contemporary Indian Women's Writing in English" on Monday. The webinar was inaugurated by Sabyasachi Bhattacharya, Principal of Gargaon College. Mrs. Anoma Bora, former Associate Professor and Vice-Principal of J.B. College, Jorhat and Dr. Indu Swami, Assistant Professor of the Department of English, Assam University, Diphu campus, had been invited as resource persons for the webinar. Professor Anoma Bora spoke about the various trends of contemporary Indian women's writing in English. She also highlighted a different angle of looking at feminism, throwing much light on the women poets. Dr. Indu Swami's deliberation reflected the contributions of women writers in the temporary period. Dr. Swami spoke about the influence of patriarchal system on women's writing. She also discussed various issues of contemporary women's writing in Indian English literature in the writings of the eastern women writers. The English department's first e-magazine was also launched on the occasion. Anoma Bora was co-moderator and Dr. Rashmi F. was the head of the English department.

Webinar focuses on women writers and their contribution

SIVASAGAR, July 6: The Department of English, Gargaon College, in collaboration with IQAC, Gargaon College, successfully organized a national webinar on the topic 'Trends in Contemporary Indian Women's Writing in English' on Monday. The webinar was inaugurated by Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, Principal of Gargaon College.

In his inaugural speech, Dr. Mahanta spoke about the emergence of a number of women writers and their contribution to the enrichment of the rich gamut of Indian English literature. Dr. Surajit Saikia, the coordinator of IQAC, Gargaon College, also spoke about the relevance of the topic referring to some eminent Indian women writers, especially focusing on north-eastern women writers.

Eminent speakers Prof. Anmona Bora, former Associate Professor and Vice-Principal of J.B. College, Jorhat and Dr. Indu Swami, Assistant Professor of the Department of English, Assam University, Diphu campus had been invited as resource persons for the webinar. Professor Anmona Bora spoke about the various trends of contemporary Indian women's writing in English.
