





Md. Karim's talk was entitled "Covid-19: Innovation and Access Dilemma" in which he tried to instigate thoughts in our minds for further direction. He talked about how innovations flourished during hard times like Covid-19, where we started with a big problem along with an opportunity. From the perspective of innovation in case of Covid-19 situation, he described how they are related as two sides of the same coin: innovation vs. access. He discussed about issues like: vaccine-IP as incentive, vaccine inequality, vaccine nationalism and IP as barrier of access. He further focussed on how the extensive support packages run the risk of damaging forthcoming productivity development due to reduced creative destruction, i.e., the cleansing of the least productive firms in the economy in the competitive process. That this risk is positively related to the generosity of the support and the length of the support period. He also talked about the risk and resilience factors at multiple ecological levels that influence individuals' mental health and wellbeing in their everyday lives and, more specifically, in disaster or outbreak situations. He further discussed how the trilateral initiatives of WTO, WHO and WIPO can collaborate each other, create a better framework about innovation at the same time about the access paradigm in terms of the critical situation. For which there is a need to go beyond IP system and develop a global pandemic framework so that we will be future ready for such type of situations.



Mr. Debasish Dutta, the speaker for the fifth session's talk was entitled "Introduction to Intellectual Property Rights". He has explained about six forms of IP rights out of seven total rights. He discussed that Intellectual property is a category of property that comprises intangible creations of the human intellect which primarily encompasses copyrights, patents and trademarks. It comprises of other types of rights including trade secrets, promotional rights, ethical rights and rights against biased competition. Artistic works like literature and music, some discoveries, inventions, symbols and designs can all be protected as intellectual property. He has explained the filing procedure and the process involved; the duration for which the rights are provided and discussed the precautions to be taken before applying patent in order to maintain the novelty of the invention. The basic criteria that one needs to file for a right includes: novelty of the invention, non-obviousness to a person skilled in the art and its industrial applicability. He further discussed how both economic as well as moral rights can be protected by IPRs and the international treaties like Berne convention and TRIPS agreement can help protect these rights in the 164 WTO member countries. The IPRs can create value and attract premium from customers; ensuring a symbol of purity. Thus, increasing the commercial value of the product. In summary, he briefed that the Intellectual property rights are the rights given to persons over the creations of their minds: inventions, literary and artistic works, and symbols, names and images used in commerce. They usually give the inventor an exclusive right over the use of his/her creation for a definite period of





Dr. Bonadio's talk was entitled "Standard Essential Patents". In his talk he deliberated how changes in the global economic environment have influenced the development of business models where intellectual property is a central element establishing value and potential growth. He discussed how the Intellectual property had grown into one of the world's biggest and fastest-growing fields of law using several real-life examples. He briefed about the recent wars between the smartphone giants over the patent matters have brought attention into the importance of Standard Essential Patents (SEPs). SEPs are patents crucial to implement a specific industry standard. He further explained how that implied to manufacture standard compliant mobile phones, tablets and other electronic devices, such manufacturers will have to use technologies that are covered by one or more SEPs. He stated that standards are technical requirements or specifications that seek to provide a common design for a product or process. He also discussed how the framework conferred considerable power on the SEP holder and using such a technological standard needed prior permission from an SEP holder, which the latter may choose to withhold by refusing to license its Patent. In his deliberation, he discussed how the FRAND declaration attempted to balance inequalities with the idea that an entity should have the right to obtain a license to desired technology on FRAND terms. But, working out a FRAND-encumbered arrangement and determining what constituted a FRAND practice was controversial.




