Vote of thanks

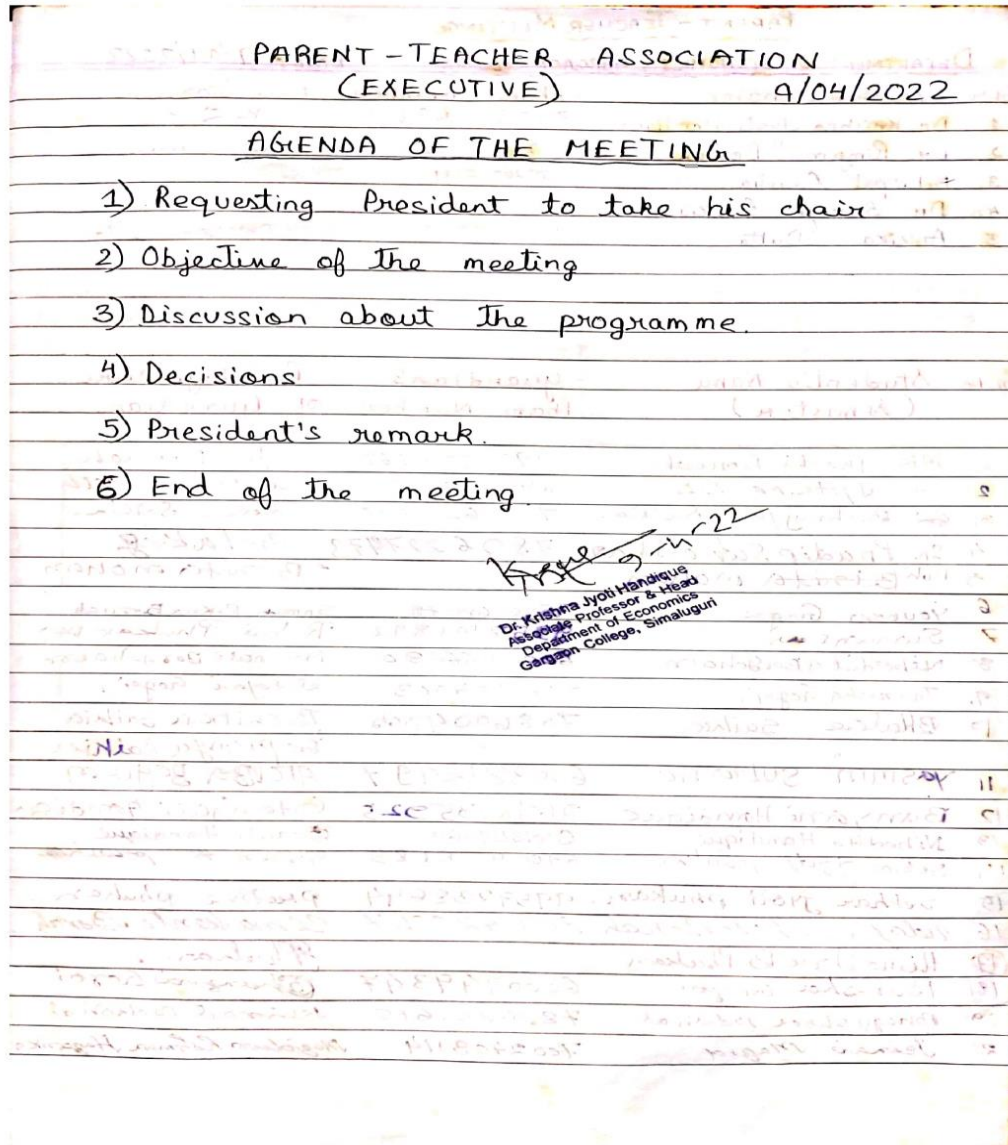
