

The Assamese Department was established in the year 1959. The Department introduced its Honours course in 1966. The department received the permanent affiliation in the year 1981. The department has a strength of six faculty members. The Department has been publishing a Wall Magazine named as RAMDHENU since 2003 prepared by the students under the supervision of the teachers. An Annual Journal JAGRITI is published by the students under the supervision and financial aid of the department teachers.

ARTICLE 4

EXECUTING AGENCY

To implement this MOU:

(1) DKDC appoints Dr. Monika Chutia, and Mridul Moran, Assistant Professor of the Department of Assamese, DKDC hereinafter referred to as DKDC rep

(2) GC appoints Devajani Bakalial, and Dr. Ankur Dutta, Assistant Professor of the Department of Assamese, GC hereinafter referred to as GC rep.

ARTICLE 5

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

(1) Any cooperation under this MOU is subject to the availability of fanding sources and approval by relevant authorities

(2) Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program-specific arrangements.

ARTICLE 6

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

(1) Each Party shall protect, within its territory, the intellectual property rights of the other party in accordance with the domestic law in force in their respective countries.

(2) In case of specific arrangements, programs, or projects that may result in intellectual property, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangements in accordance with their respective laws and regulations.

ARTICLE 7

CONFIDENTIALITY

In the event that either Party wishes to disclose any data or information supplied from the implementation of this MOU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent from the other Party.

ARTICLE 8

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the Parties.

ARTICLE 9

AMENDMENT

(1) This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of The Parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.

(2) Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

ARTICLE 10

ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION, AND TERMINATION

(1) This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.

(2) This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for another period of five (5) years by mutual written consent of the Parties.

(3) Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.

(4) The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any projects and programs in progress and not completed at the time of termination


2. Talk on "Solution to Plastic Pollution" by Dr. Arandao Narzary





f) Facilitate student interaction with start-ups.



8) Display of Logo: This MoU is for an initial period of 2 years and during that period both the parties will display the logo of the partner organization on their respective website.

9) Amendment: Amendments to this MOU may be made at any time through the mutually written consent by the parties concerned.
