Groundwater Contamination of Arsenic and its Toxicity

Abstract

Arsenic (As) is a toxic element with distinct physical characteristics and has been reported as toxic to public health. Recent reports have registered increasing level of ground water contamination with arsenic worldwide. In India also most of the states has been reported to have Arsenic contaminated groundwater. As most of the population are dependent on ground water for drinking water, the exposure rate to As is very high. The toxicity of arsenic varies across the different forms (arsenite, arsenate, arsenic acid and arsenic disulfide). Its exposure has been reported to be involved in incidence of skin and lung cancer. There are also reports of its significant association to liver, prostate, and bladder cancer. The cellular toxicity of living organisms is linked with the levels of reactive oxygen species (ROS) that play an important role in normal cell signaling. The abnormal production of ROS can result in oxidative stress of cells that are activated by other mechanisms. ROS production can lead to DNA damage involving the formation of 8-hydroxydeoxythymine (8-OHdTh) and 8-hydroxydeoxyguanosine (8-OHdG), which is considered as a marker indicating oxidative stress of DNA. Therefore, it can be hypothesized that ROS generation is a major pathway for arsenic-mediated genotoxicity to mammalian cells. Although numerous reports have linked As exposure to incidence of cancer, the complete mechanism of carcinogenicity is still not understood. The present study aims to summarize the present knowledge on groundwater contamination of As and their effects.

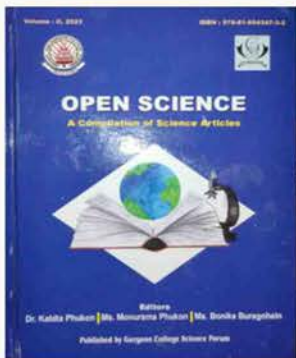

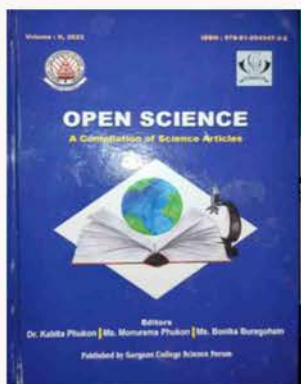

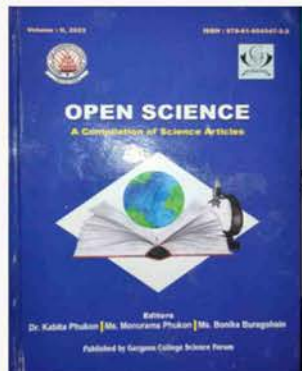
ABSTRACT

Introduction
 In the recent world, the consumption pattern of the people has been changed and people prefer high value added agricultural commodities. Production of Mushroom is considered one of the high value added and nutrition rich agricultural commodities. In the developed countries, different research studies have found that 7 out of 10 people eat mushroom regularly and in Indian markets, demand for mushroom is growing at over 25% PA (Data as per MAC Plan by Ministry of Food Processing). In Assam, mushroom farming is not a popular farm enterprise as compared to other states of India. However, the agro-climatic condition in North East are conducive for Mushrooms and the availability of raw material is good for several species of mushroom to be grown in a cost effective manner (Rai, 2008). Further Mushrooms have the potential to impact livelihoods of poor, landless and marginalized farmers as it takes much lesser space to grow, as it is cultivated in a house vertically making it ideal for women to pursue.
