MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "MOU") is entered on 02-05-2022 between Dergaon Kamal Dowarah College, Dergaon, Assam and Gargaon College, Assam.

Dergaon Kamal Dowarah College, Assam, hereinafter referred as "DKDC" and Gargaon College, Assam, hereinafter referred as "GC", hereinafter individually referred to as "the Party" and jointly referred as "the Parties";

ACKNOWLEDGING that;

1. DKDC (NAAC accredited with 'B' Grade) was established in 1962 with a vision of academic, social, cultural, and economic development in the greater Dergaon area and with clear objectives to provide better education to meet global requirements successfully. The institution ascertains the unity and integrity among the people of different communities and religions and also the uplift of the downtrodden of the region. The College currently provides both Higher Secondary and Three-Year Bachelor's Degree (Honours and Non-Honours) courses to more than two thousand students every academic year. The College has three faculties: Arts, Science and Commerce spread over sixteen departments, viz. Assamese, Economics, English, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Geography, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Computer Science, Statistics, and, Commerce. The college also has post-graduate courses under Dibrugarh University in four subjects (Assamese, Economics, Physics, and Chemistry). The college has over 12 Add-on Courses approved by the Dibrugarh University.

The Assamese Department was established in the year 1962. The Department introduced its Honours course in 1968. The department has a strength of six faculty members. The Department has been publishing a Wall Magazine named as JONAK, Hand-Written Magazine AYAN, and an annual journal DAPON.

2. One of the oldest and illustrious institutions of higher education in Assam, GC (NAAC accredited with 'B' Grade) was established on 7th September 1959. With a commitment to achieve excellence in higher learning, the college has been working relentlessly for the development of the learner as well as the furtherance of social good. Dr. Harendra Nath Phukan was the founder Principal of the college. The College currently provides both Higher Secondary and Three-Year



Bachelor's Degree (Honours and Non-Honours) courses to more than two thousand students every academic year. The College has three faculties: Arts, Science and Commerce spread over seventeen departments, viz. Assamese, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Geology, History, Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Rural Development, Sociology, Statistics, and Zoology. The college also has post-graduate courses under Dibrugarh University in five subjects (Economics, Education, English, History, and Political Science). The college has 23 Add-on Courses approved by the Dibrugarh University.

The Assamese Department was established in the year 1959. The Department introduced its Honours course in 1966. The department received the permanent affiliation in the year 1981. The department has a strength of six faculty members. The Department has been publishing a Wall Magazine named as RAMDHENU since 2003 prepared by the students under the supervision of the teachers. An Annual Journal JAGRITI is published by the students under the supervision and financial aid of the department teachers.

DESIRING to support the cooperation between the Parties in education and training programs;

PURSUANT TO the prevailing laws and regulations, policies, and procedures of India.

HAVE REACHED the following understanding:

**ARTICLE 1
OBJECTIVE OF COOPERATION**

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to cooperate in educational projects in areas of mutual interest.

**ARTICLE 2
SCOPE OF COOPERATION**

The Parties agree to implement cooperation programs including but not limited to:

- a. Exchange on best practices
- b. Faculty and student exchanges
- c. Conduct seminars and workshops
- d. Curriculum development
- e. E-content development
- f. Other areas as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

**ARTICLE 3
LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES**

- (1) The Parties agree to implement the programs stated in Article 2 at DKDC and GC, and online mode. Special emphasis will be given to online mode.
- (2) Any changes in the location of the programs shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

**ARTICLE 4
EXECUTING AGENCY**

To implement this MOU:

- (1) DKDC appoints **Dr. Monika Chutia**, and **Mridul Moran**, Assistant Professor of the Department of Assamese, DKDC hereinafter referred to as DKDC rep.
- (2) GC appoints **Devajani Bakalia**, and **Dr. Ankur Dutta**, Assistant Professor of the Department of Assamese, GC hereinafter referred to as GC rep.

**ARTICLE 5
FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT**

- (1) Any cooperation under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval by relevant authorities.
- (2) Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program-specific arrangements.

**ARTICLE 6
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

- (1) Each Party shall protect, within its territory, the intellectual property rights of the other party in accordance with the domestic law in force in their respective countries.
- (2) In case of specific arrangements, programs, or projects that may result in intellectual property, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangements in accordance with their respective laws and regulations.

**ARTICLE 7
CONFIDENTIALITY**

In the event that either Party wishes to disclose any data or information supplied from the implementation of this MOU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent from the other Party.

**ARTICLE 8
SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES**

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the Parties.

**ARTICLE 9
AMENDMENT**

- (1) This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of The Parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- (2) Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

**ARTICLE 10
ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION, AND TERMINATION**

- (1) This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- (2) This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for another period of five (5) years by mutual written consent of the Parties.
- (3) Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.
- (4) The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any projects and programs in progress and not completed at the time of termination.

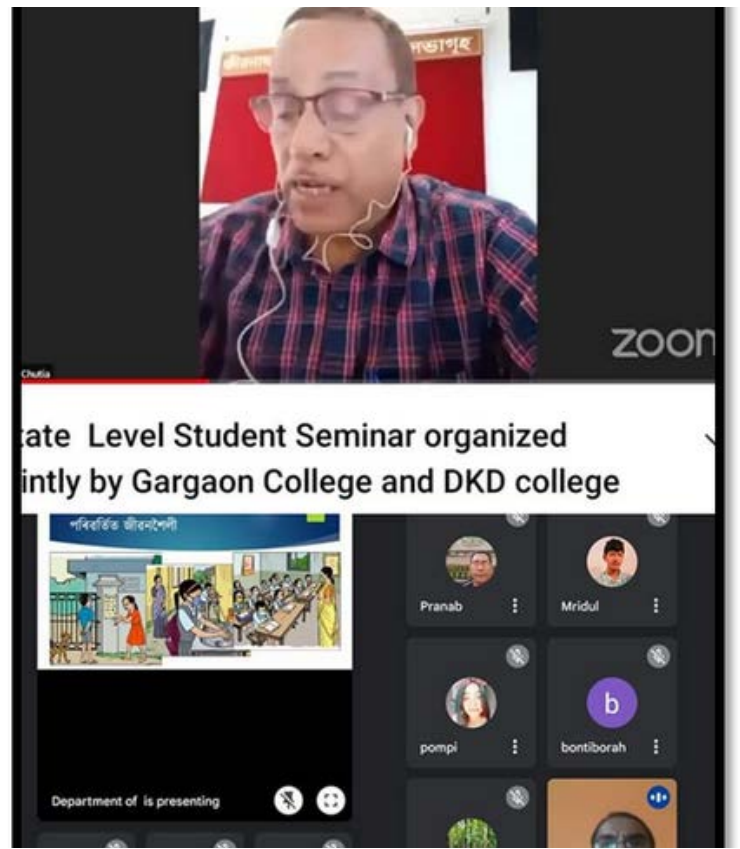
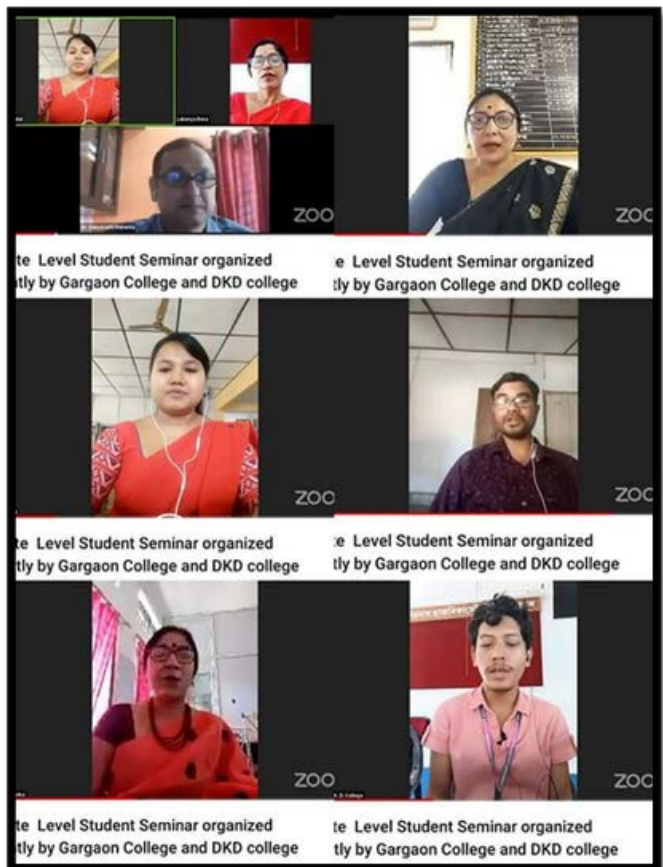
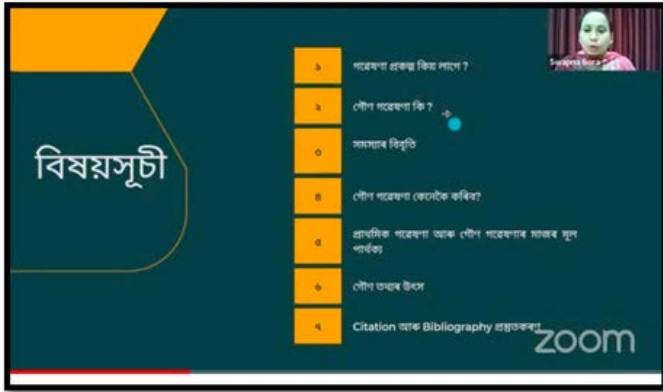

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 6th January of 2021 at Jorhat (Assam)

BETWEEN

Gargaon College, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors in office and assigns, hereinafter referred to as "First Party".

AND

Assam Agricultural University (AAU), Jorhat-785013, email: deec@aau.ac.in, represented by Dr. P.K. Pathak, Director of Extension Education (DEE), AAU, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors in office and assigns, hereinafter called as the "Second Party". To impart both theoretical and hands-on training for Self-financed Certificate Courses to the students of Gargaon College under the following terms and conditions:

1. The First Party proposes to organise Certificate Courses on (a) Biofertilizers-Vermi Composting and (b) Mushroom Cultivation and approaches the Second Party for technical assistance to the students of the institution.
2. The Second Party agrees to impart both theoretical and hands-on training, particularly to the students of the institution for Self-financed Certificate Courses.
3. The First Party will provide its infrastructural facilities and their logistics as and when required for training to be used by the second party for these courses.
4. The Second Party agrees to provide faculty for both theoretical and hands-on training. However, the faculty will conduct the classes as per their conveniences without hampering the mandated activities. The First Party may also provide faculty for any assistance if required by the Second Party.
5. The Second Party may decide to impart training to the students in their campus as and when they deem fit as per requirement of the courses.
6. The First Party agrees to bear the travelling expenses and honorarium of the faculty and other expenses that may be necessary for conducting the course.



7. Both the parties agree to design the time-table of the courses without hampering the regular class routines.
8. The First Party will be responsible for all academic matters relating to the course and necessary guidance and support may be taken from the Second Party as and when required.
9. The First Party agrees to issue Course Completion Certificates to the students wherein the Second Party will also be a signatory.
10. The First Party shall, hereupon, be responsible for publicity of the courses after mutual understanding between the two parties.
11. In case of any difference of opinion occurs between the two parties regarding the aforementioned conditions, the matter may be resolved jointly by both the parties.

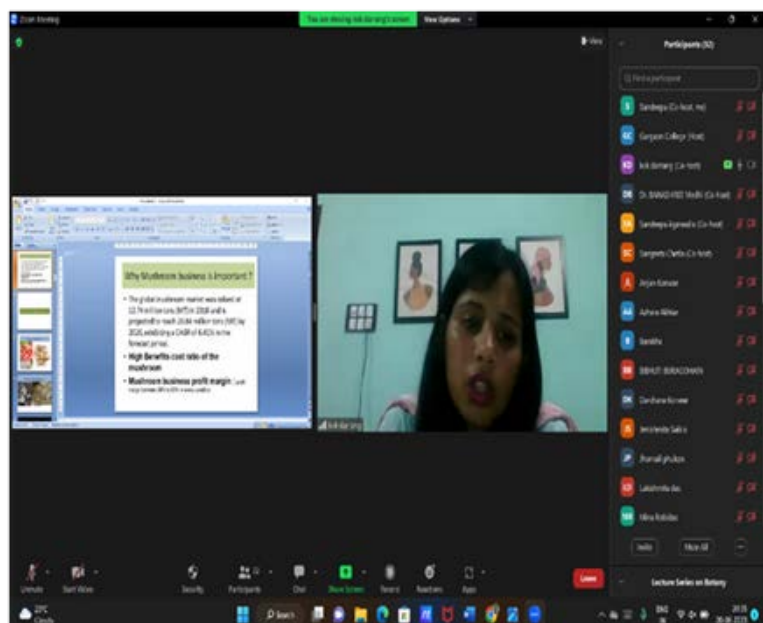
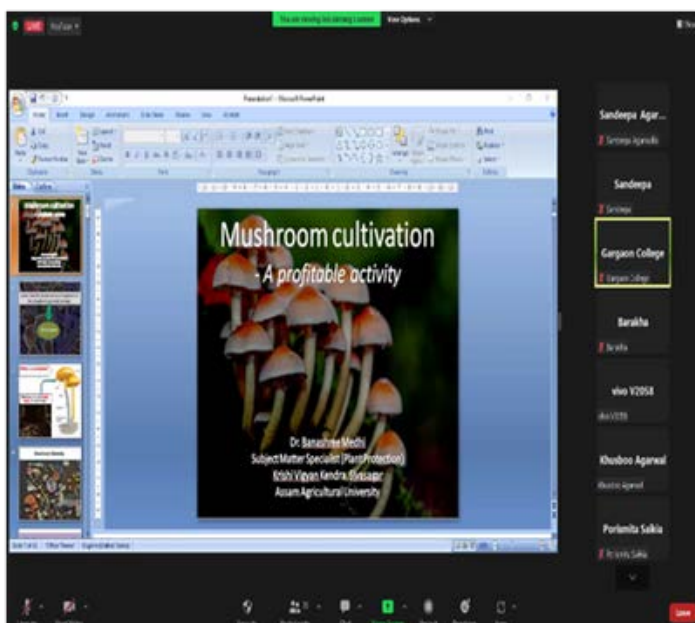

- f) IQAC Coordinator, Sibsagar Girls' College



2. Talk on “Solution to Plastic Pollution” by Dr. Arandao Narzary

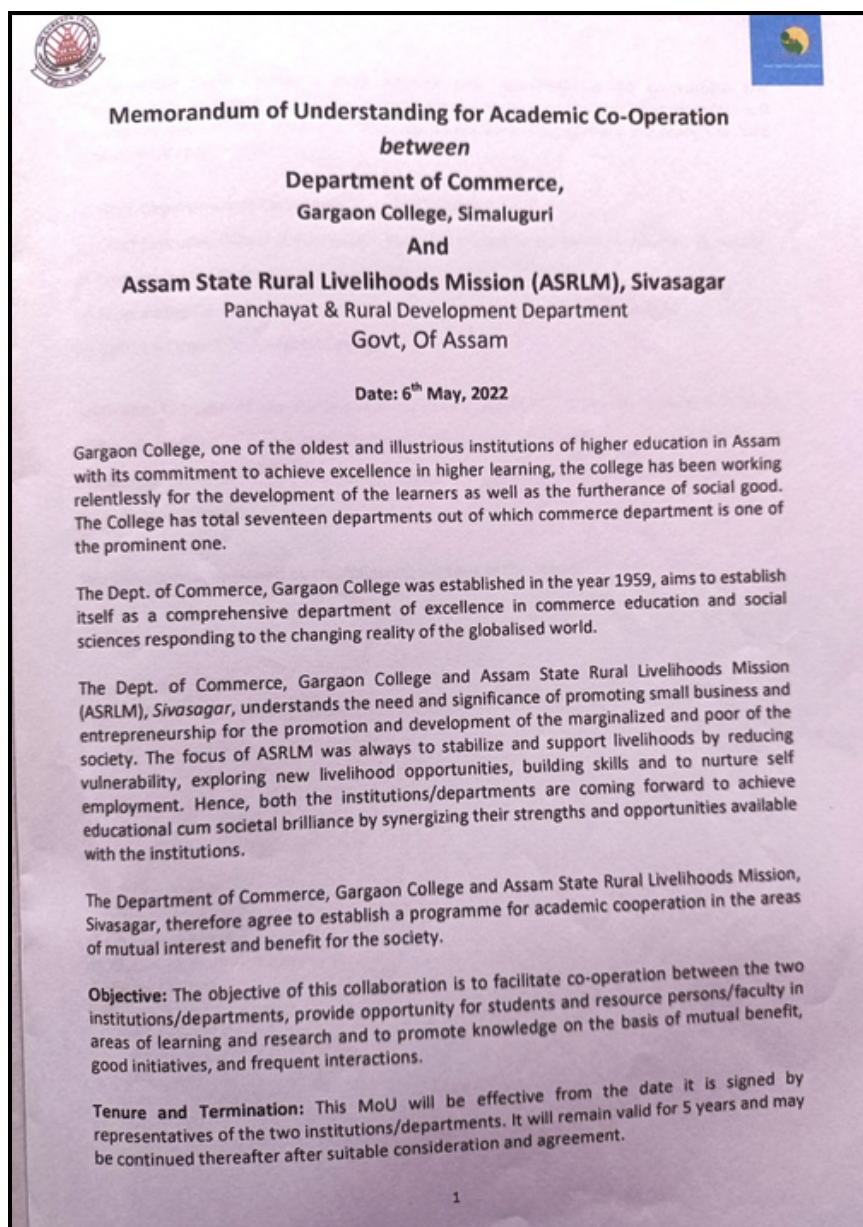

3) Roles and Responsibilities of Assam Startup – The Nest:

- Assam Startup Nest shall facilitate creation of a network of Entrepreneurship Development Cells and Competency Centres located within the academic institutions.
- Promote and facilitate the setting up of Entrepreneurship Development Cells within the academic institutions which do not have one.
- Carry out capacity building of Entrepreneurship Development Cell personnel under "Train the Trainer" program, free of cost.
- Conduct district level Outreach events to promote entrepreneurship at the grassroots level.
- Conduct Networking meets for the Academic Partners to facilitate interaction between the institutions and leverage the strength of each other.
- Conduct state level B-Plan Contest / Startup Hunt for start-ups.
- Provide incubation support (physical / virtual) to advanced level start-ups selected through the contests / hunts.
- Provide access to common resources like mentors, experts, and investors.

4) Responsibilities of Academic Partner: The Academic Partner (AP) shall:

- Create a formal Entrepreneurship Development Cell or leverage existing Entrepreneurship Development Cell / Incubator to conduct Entrepreneurship Awareness and Motivation workshops / talks to encourage students to participate in entrepreneurship related activities.
- Help in conducting Outreach programs within the respective districts.
- Conduct Hackathons or ideation events to encourage students to come up with ideas.
- Provide support to the students with innovative ideas.
- Organize an Annual conference and Business plan contest to identify and recognize the budding entrepreneurs.
- Facilitate student interaction with start-ups.
- Make best efforts to support start-ups from the region with knowledge and access to resources (e.g. incubation facility, technology labs), so that innovative ideas can be transformed into successful business ventures.
- Take care of the expenses for conducting the internal programs or contests.
- Take care of the cost of travel, boarding, and lodging (if applicable) for the personnel attending capacity building or networking meets at the Assam Startup - The Nest.

5) Non Exclusivity: The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be non-exclusive and both the parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries, and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind.

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU) is made the 11th day of July, 2022 between Assam Startup – The Nest, through IIM Calcutta Innovation Park (IIMCIP), registered as a Section 8 company and having its office at IIM Calcutta, Diamond Harbor Road, Joka, Kolkata 700104, India and Department of Commerce, Gargaon College, having office at Simaluguri, Sivasagar Assam, Pin -785686, herein after referred to as Academic Partner (AP).

Assam Startup – The Nest, and its affiliates, hereinafter together shall be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

1) Background and Purpose:

a) **Background:** The Assam Government has launched the Assam Startup Policy to promote entrepreneurship and the growth of startup culture in the state. To implement the policy, the Government has recently initiated the "Assam Startup" program, which aims to catalyze the startup movement in the state by motivating the youth to become job creators and providing necessary ecosystem support so that they may pursue their entrepreneurial dreams. A key element in this program is the state incubation center named "Assam Startup - The Nest", at Guwahati. The Assam Startup - The Nest is conceptualized as the hub for entrepreneurship development in the state and would facilitate district level entrepreneurship development with the support of the entrepreneurship development centers or incubators located within the institutes across the state. The Government has invited IIMCIP to be a knowledge partner for the initiative and manage the operations of the Assam Startup - The Nest.

b) **The Objective:** This engagement will support the objectives mentioned in the Assam Startup Policy:

- Create a state-wide inclusive entrepreneurial ecosystem;
- Promote entrepreneurship, create awareness, and motivate the youth;
- Provide physical and virtual incubation services;
- Create 1000 startups in 5 years time;
- Create 1 lakh direct and indirect employment;
- Facilitate External Funding for startups.

2) Understanding between the two Parties:

- Both parties acknowledge the need to create an ecosystem for promoting innovation and entrepreneurship and are interested in partnering to further this cause.
- There is a need to inculcate an entrepreneurial/problem-solving mindset among the students.

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6) Validity and Termination: This MOU is for an initial period of 2 years and may be amended or terminated earlier by a mutually written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party.

7) Assignment: It is understood by the Parties herein that this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party, and hence, neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.
