

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






GPS Map Camera



E.Greviance Redressal

Grievance Redressal System of Department of Geography, Gargaon College

At the Department of Geography at Gargaon College, we value your feedback and are committed to resolving any grievances or concerns you may have. Our Grievance Redressal System aims to provide a fair and transparent mechanism for addressing issues and ensuring a conducive environment for learning and growth. The Grievance is formulated to address the issues or complaint related to internal exams conducted by the department. The department after each Sessional exam displays marks obtained by student on the notice board to avail and provide a period of 7 days to intimate any grievance related to the exam. The following instructions are required to follow for grievance redressal.

1. Grievance Redressal Cell: The Grievance Redressal Cell, established within the Department of Geography, is responsible for handling and resolving grievances. Submit your written complaint/ verbal statement to the Grievance Redressal Cell through one of the following channels:

a. Physical Submission: Deliver a printed copy of your grievance statement to the Department of Geography's office. Ensure it is addressed to the Grievance Redressal Cell (Department of Geography).

b. Students who want to register for Grievance can contact physically the faculties of department of Geography regarding any issues / complain after the Sessional exams. Grievances are acceptable only for a period of one week from the date of display of

- Sessional marks on notice board.
- 2. Grievance Evaluation: Upon receiving your complaint, the Grievance Redressal Cell will review the details provided and evaluate the matter objectively. They may contact you for further information or clarification if required. The cell will treat your grievance with confidentiality and professionalism.
- 3. Grievance Resolution: The Grievance Redressal Cell will initiate appropriate action to address the grievance effectively. They will investigate the matter, consult relevant parties, and take necessary steps towards resolution. You will be informed of the progress and outcome of the investigation within a reasonable timeframe.
- Feedback and Follow-up: We encourage you to provide feedback on the grievance 4. redressal process, whether your grievance is resolved or not. Your input will help us improve the system and ensure a better experience for everyone. Additionally, feel free to follow up with the Grievance Redressal Cell or relevant authorities to seek updates on the progress of your complaint.
