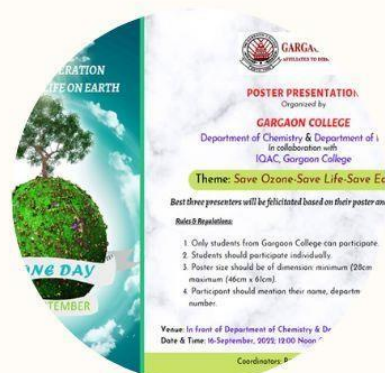

World Ozone Day is observed on September 16 every year to spread awareness among people about the depletion of Ozone Layer and find possible solutions to preserve it. On this day, people from all over the world hold talks and seminars on the ozone layer. Educators teach students about the benefits of the Ozone layer and special events and activities are organised to spread awareness.

About the Program:

The event was inaugurated by distinguished academician and acclaimed author Dr Sabyasachi Mahanta, Principal, Gargaon College. In his inauguration address, he urged the students to reflect on the Montreal Protocol of September 16, 1987, which placed a halt to one of the greatest risks to humanity's survival as a whole: the ozone layer's depletion. Dr Mahanta said, today, with the slogan "Ozone for life," marks 35 years since the original Montreal Protocol was signed. He emphasized on the role of ozone in protection of earth from the harmful portion of the rays of the sun, thus helping preserve life on the planet. In his speech, he also appreciated the joint efforts of Chemistry and Physics department in efficiently organizing the event to create awareness among the students about the importance of ozone layer. Dr Dilip Kumar Deka, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Geography, delved into further detail about the location of the ozone layer. Diganta Konwar, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Physics, laid out the goals of the event to the audience and Dr Anna Gogoi, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Chemistry introduced the judges and congratulated the students on their active participation. A poster competition was also organized on that day. More than 50 posters were presented by the students among which Ankur Gogoi from Zoology Department, Protyasha Borkotoky from Chemistry Department, Gayatree Borgohain from Physics Department and Riya Devi from Zoology Department were adjudged first, second, third, and consolation prizes, respectively. The programme was attended by around 100 students and several members from the teaching community and staff of the college.


