## **CONCEPT NOTE OF THE SEMINAR**

The COVID-19 pandemic has changed the entire world drastically. The Government of India in the month of May 2020 gave a call for Atmanirbhar Bharat together with the announcements of a special economic package of rupees twenty lakh crores to enhance the economic empowerment of the underprivileged, laborers, and migrants. Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan or Self-reliant India campaign is the vision of New India envisaged by the Government of India with the aim to give a new boost to the economic potential of the country. The term 'Atmanirbhar' is used as an umbrella concept in relation to making India "a bigger and more important part of the global economy" by pursuing policies that are efficient, competitive resilient, and being self-sustaining, and self-generating. The five Pillars, namely economy, infrastructure, technology-driven system, vibrant demography, and demand have been considered essential to make India self-reliant.

The Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan envisages preparing India for severe competition in global supply chains, improving business ease, empowering MSMEs, attracting investments, particularly FDI, and boosting Make in India policies. In a nutshell, it advocates a 'voice for local'. The basic idea is to promote local industries and consume local produce wherever possible so that the long-term effects of an increase in demand can be used to develop the domestic industries and make them gradually self-reliant.

Many policymakers have envisaged the possibility of utilizing the diverse potential of North East India in order to boost 'Atmanirbhar Bharat'. The region has a huge scope to drive and propel growth and socio-economic development. Rich natural resources combined with a wide scope of tourism, cottage industries, sustainable agriculture, small and medium business sectors etc., and indigenous practices give the northeast the potential to play a key role in the journey of development.

However, despite the efforts at policy formulation to cater to the developmental needs of the northeastern region, a development strategy based upon prevailing resources, conditions, and people's needs and priorities of the region needs to be envisaged in order to cope with the vast disparities within the region. The development strategy for the various tribes in the region will have to be participatory and should be calibrated in their own setting. In this direction, deliberations and discussions are essential to bring together researchers, academicians, professionals, and students from different areas to interact and disseminate information on the prospects and challenges of Atmanirbhar Bharat.

## Overview of the Seminar

Apart from pointing out the areas with scope for entrepreneurship, he also argued that India needs to work on import substitution and export promotion for self-reliance. Dr. Shyamolima Saikia, Assistant Professor of English at Gargaon College, anchored the inaugural session.

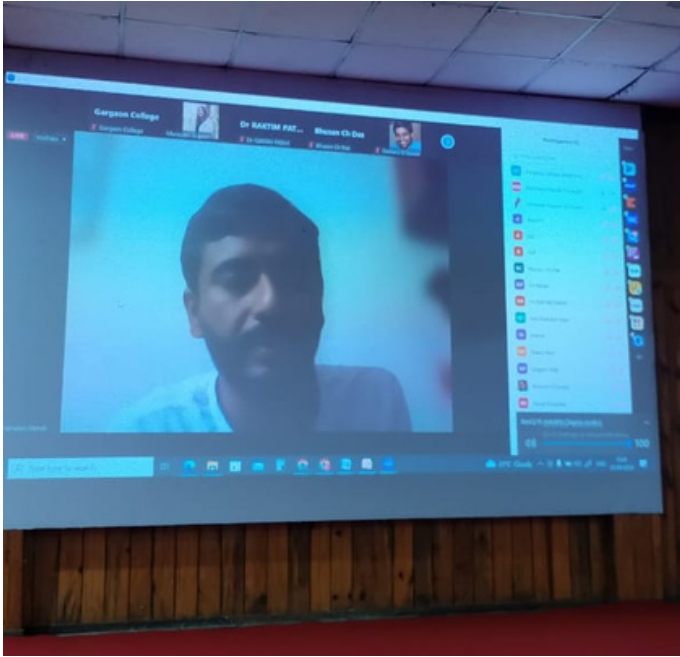

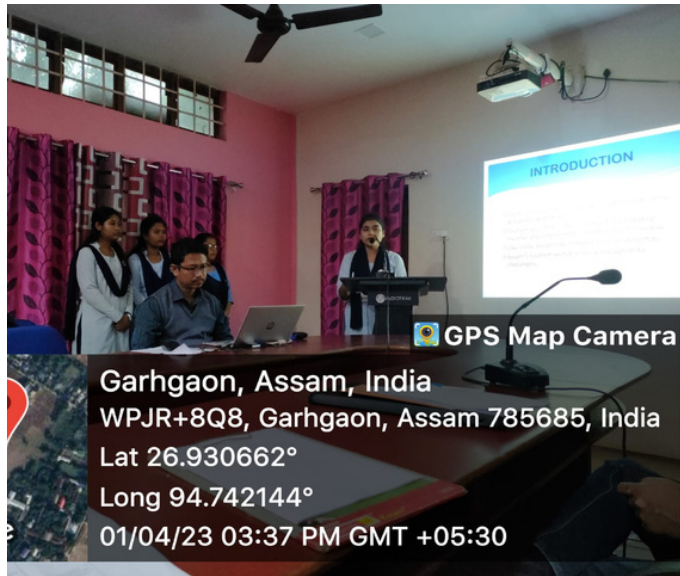

GPS Map Camera

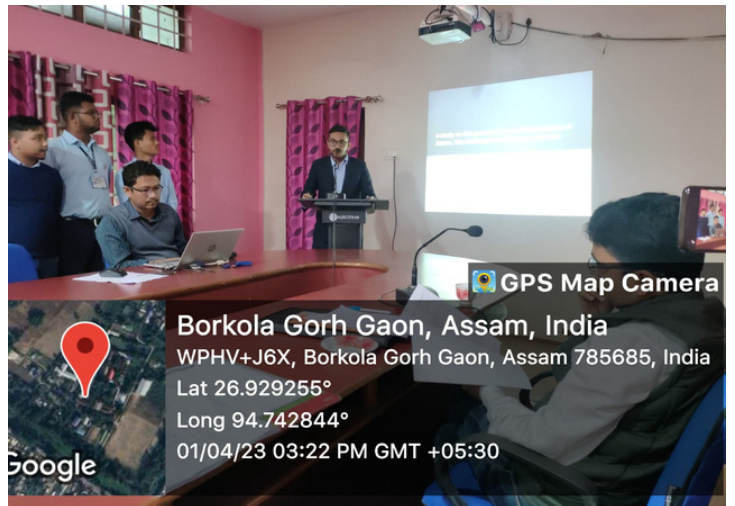
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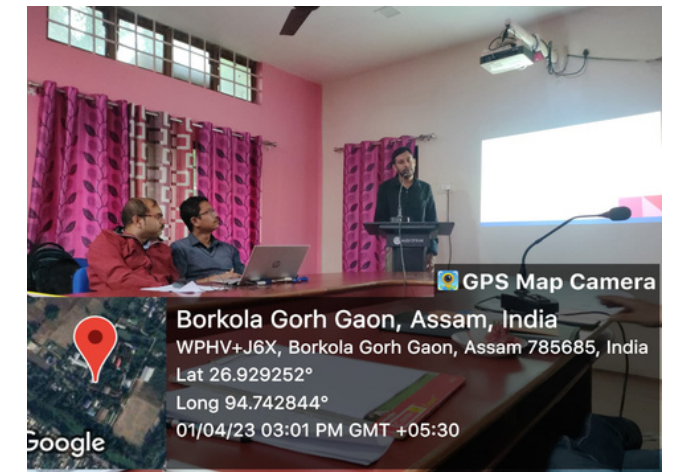

'Atmanirbhar Bharat not about incremental growth but human capacity building'

SIVASAGAR, April 2: In tune with the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahtosav, IQAC of Gargaon College of Sivasagar organized a national seminar on 'Atmanirbhar Bharat: Opportunities and Challenges with Special Focus on North East India' on Saturday.

Speaking at the event, Dr Sabyasachi Mahanta, eminent academic, poet, and Principal of Gargaon College, highlighted that an Atmanirbhar Bharat (self-reliant India) advocates 'vocal for local'. The Atmanirbhar Bharat mission, under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, envisages preparing India for severe competition in global supply chains, improving business, empowering MSMEs, attracting investments, particularly FDI, and boosting

'Make in India' policies. Dr Mahanta hoped that deliberations in the national seminar would go a long way in paving the way for new thinking and successful implementation of the mission of Atmanirbhar Bharat.

Biman Chandra Boruah, the governing body president, inaugurated the seminar. In his keynote address, Prof Debabrata Das, the Vice Chancellor of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Co-operative Management, inspired the audience with his thought-provoking lecture on 'Strategizing for Atmanirbhar Bharat'. Prof Das highlighted that Atmanirbhar Bharat was not about incremental growth but human capacity building and preparing for a quantum jump to transform the Indian economy into a US\$ 7 trillion economic powerhouse in the next two decades. He pointed out

that the five pillars of Atmanirbhar Bharat were economy, infrastructure, system, demography, and demand.

Another dignitary of the inaugural session was Dr Alok Ranjan Dutta, Associate Professor, Department of Economics, who briefly highlighted the prospects and challenges of Atmanirbhar Bharat. Apart from pointing out the areas with scope for entrepreneurship, he also argued that India needed to work on import substitution and export promotion for self-reliance.

Dr Shyamolima Saikia, Assistant Professor of English at Gargaon College, anchored the inaugural session. Researchers and academics from different parts of India participated in the event and presented about 40 research papers in the seminar that was held in a hybrid mode.
