The MoU between Gargaon College and Assam Agricultural University was signed on 6th January, 2021, to enhance theoretical and hands on training activity to the students by conducting different seminars, workshop and faculty exchange program.

On 20th June, 2023, Miss Banashree Medhi, Subject Matter Specialist (Plant Protection), Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Sivasagar, Assam, discussed on mushroom farming as a profitable business. She gave an explanation of mushrooms, including how to recognize them, their nutritional value, and finally the business potential it holds.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 6th January of 2021 at Jorhat (Assam)

BETWEEN

Gargaon College, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors in office and assigns, hereinafter referred to as "First Party".

AND

Assam Agricultural University (AAU), Jorhat-785013, email: dec@aau.ac.in, represented by Dr. P.K. Pathak, Director of Extension Education (DEE), AAU, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors in office and assigns, hereinafter called as the "Second Party". To impart both theoretical and hands-on training for Self-financed Certificate Courses to the students of Gargaon College under the following terms and conditions:

1. The First Party proposes to organise Certificate Courses on (a) Biofertilizers-Vermi Composting and (b) Mushroom Cultivation and approaches the Second Party for technical assistance to the students of the institution.
2. The Second Party agrees to impart both theoretical and hands-on training, particularly to the students of the institution for Self-financed Certificate Courses.
3. The First Party will provide its infrastructural facilities and their logistics as and when required for training to be used by the second party for these courses.
4. The Second Party agrees to provide faculty for both theoretical and hands-on training. However, the faculty will conduct the classes as per their conveniences without hampering the mandated activities. The First Party may also provide faculty for any assistance if required by the Second Party.
5. The Second Party may decide to impart training to the students in their campus as and when they deem fit as per requirement of the courses.
6. The First Party agrees to bear the travelling expenses and honorarium of the faculty and other expenses that may be necessary for conducting the course.



7. Both the parties agree to design the time-table of the courses without hampering the regular class routines.
8. The First Party will be responsible for all academic matters relating to the course and necessary guidance and support may be taken from the Second Party as and when required.
9. The First Party agrees to issue Course Completion Certificates to the students wherein the Second Party will also be a signatory.
10. The First Party shall, hereupon, be responsible for publicity of the courses after mutual understanding between the two parties.
11. In case of any difference of opinion occurs between the two parties regarding the aforementioned conditions, the matter may be resolved jointly by both the parties.

Brief report of the program

A workshop cum Hands-on Training on Mushroom Cultivation. Dr. Banashree Medhi, Subject Matter Specialist (Plant Protection) Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Sivasagar and Dr. Prodip Handique, Senior Scientist & Head, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Sivasagar conducted the hands-on training. They provided hands-on training to the students. They elaborated on several aspects of mushrooms including some of the theoretical aspects of the cultivation part. They were trained in House spawn generation, layering and spawning and controlling humidity and temperature requirements that are crucial. Lastly they talked on the importance it holds for self-employment.

Rationality of the Program

The objective of the hands-on training on mushroom cultivation was to provide participants especially the students with practical skills and knowledge in the cultivation of mushrooms. Through a combination of theoretical sessions and hands-on practice, participants were expected to gain proficiency in the technique of handling spawns and the environment required for mushroom cultivation.



The Department of Economics in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Gargaon College organised a 'One Day Workshop on Agricultural Entrepreneurship for Green Livelihood' on 15th September at the college premises. The workshop started with a welcome speech by Dr. Krishnajyoti Handique, Head of the Department of Economics. Dr. Handique outlined the objective of this workshop. The workshop was organised in order to create awareness among students regarding the scope of agricultural entrepreneurship as a pivotal driver for creating jobs as well as for sustainable livelihood. The workshop was moderated by Borsha Gogoi, a 5th semester student and Dr Rimjim Borah, a faculty of the Department of Economics.

The workshop was inaugurated by noted academician, renowned educationist and Principal of the Gargaon College, Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta. In his inaugural speech, Dr. Mahanta highlighted the significance of agriculture for self-employment, self-reliance and for community development as well as for green livelihood. Dr. Mahanta stressed that there is an urgent need of organised and well managed agripreneurs in order to achieve tremendous growth in agriculture and allied sector in the country. Dr Rina Handique, Vice-Principal of the college shared her expertise and experiences related with pisciculture and other agri-activities.

Brief report of the program

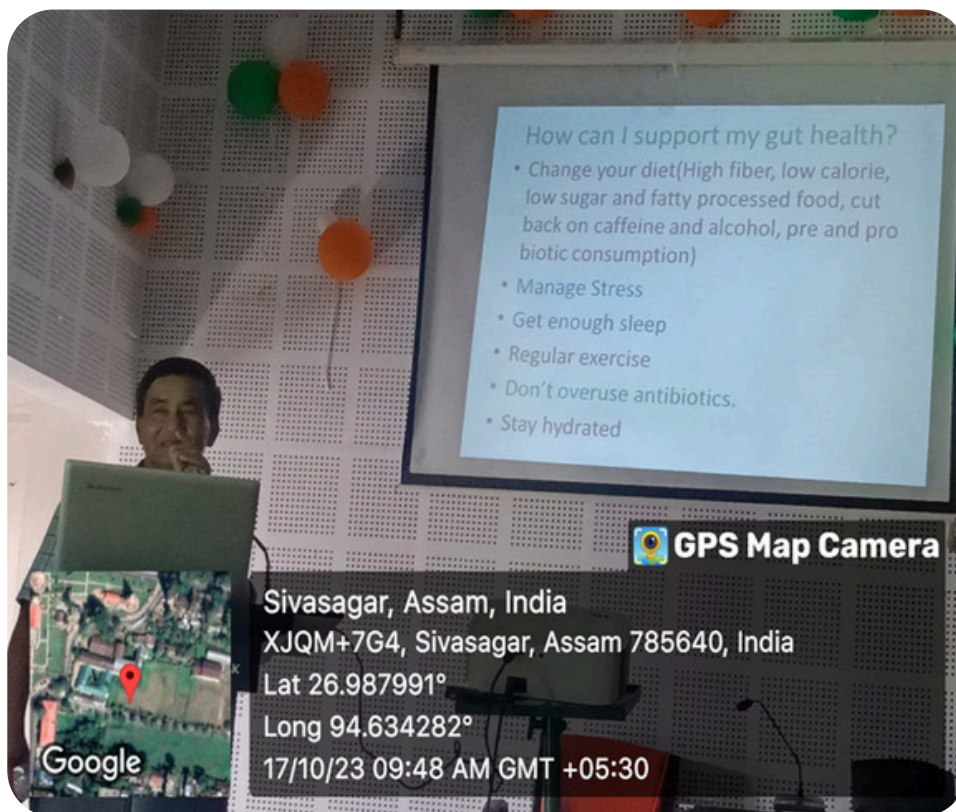

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day, 12th December, 2023 between **THE ASSAM ROYAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY**, a state private University, established by The Assam Royal Global University Act 2013 (to be read with The Assam Private Universities Act 2007), notified by the Government of Assam Gazette on 23/8/2013, herein after referred to as "**FIRST PARTY/RGU**", having its campus at Betkuchi, NH-37, Guwahati-781035, Assam Starting its first academic session in July 2017, RGU currently offers multiple courses in diversified fields.

And

GARGAON COLLEGE, herein after referred to as "**SECOND PARTY/Gargaon College**" is one of the oldest and illustrious institutions of higher education in Assam, Gargaon College was established on 7th September 1959. With a commitment to achieve excellence in higher learning the college has been working relentlessly for the development of the learner as well as the furtherance of social good. The college came under the deficit-grants-in-aid system of the Government of Assam in the year 1966 and had also been included under section 12 (B) and (f) of UGC Act 1956 under the affiliation of Dibrugarh University. The College was assessed and accredited by the *National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC)* for the first time in the year 2004. It was re-accredited for the second time in the year 2010. Most recently NAAC re-accredited the college with 'B-Grade' in the year 2019. College Address: Simaluguri, District Sivasagar, Assam, Pin-785686

The Assam Royal Global University, Guwahati and Gargaon College are hereinafter collectively referred to as 'the Parties/Universities/Institutions' and individually as 'the Party/University/Institution'.

2. Purpose:

Amrita

That the broad objective of this agreement is to have a common platform for Research / Faculty and Student Exchange Program/ Summer & Winter Internship/ Projects/ Joint Consultancy/ Joint Training Programs/ Effective implementation of NEP 2020 also considering issues related to NAAC, NIRF and UGC notifications on UTSAH and PoP etc. and other activities as agreed upon by both the parties.

3. Statement of Mutual Benefits & Interests:

- 3.1 Together, these two parties shall work towards furthering cooperation in both education, training & academic research which will be mutually beneficial for both institutions.
- 3.2 Parties shall work in cooperation for research activities; joint training programs; exchange of faculty members; summer programs; student exchange; joint publications & sharing of information, etc. in addition to taking advantage of RGU's multi-disciplinary, inter-disciplinary, vocational degree thus, providing benefit to the students of the college under the NEP 2020 scenario.

4. Forms of Cooperation:

The Parties envisage the following cooperation within the scope of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU):

4.1: Exchange of Faculty members

For planning and handling of academic programs and courses, organization of seminars, workshops and conferences including the exchange of mutual experiences in teaching, research, and industrial practices with prior approval from parent institutions. Honorarium, transportation, and accommodation/hospitality as per institution norms.

4.2: Exchange in Research

Through joint programs in research and development, including provision of Summer/Winter Internship Programme for the students of RGU and vice versa. During the period, either institution will provide hostel accommodation to the visiting students as per the institution norms. Prior approval and agreement of the head of the concerned department of the institutions is to be obtained to allow students to work in laboratories for projects, internships, etc. The Vice-Chancellor/Registrar/Principals of the universities/institutions will be the sole authority to grant final approval.

4.3: Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects

RGU faculty will involve some of the selected faculties of Gargaon College (depending upon their interest and expertise in a chosen domain) to be Co-investigators in their project proposals for funding and vice versa. Faculty members involved in any such projects will need to seek prior approval from respective Heads of the Institution.

4.4: Seminars / Symposia / Workshop/ Training Programs to be jointly organized

To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs, to organize seminars, conferences, training programs or workshops on topics of mutual interest, and invite faculty members from both the institutions to participate therein. However, for specific co-operation, projects shall be negotiated separately between the Parties and, in each specific case, shall be established as separate written agreements, stating the respective rights and obligations of the Parties.

4.5 Co-Curricular activities (Sports, culture, debate, quiz etc.)

RGU and Gargaon College may conduct some Inter-University joint events, joint camps, training for specific sports etc. with mutual consultation.

5. Financial Obligations:

There will be no financial obligations on both the parties under this agreement.

6. General Coordinators:

Each party shall designate an administrative office/ department to oversee and facilitate the implementation of any agreements arising out of this MoU.

7. Intellectual Property Rights:

RGU and Gargaon College agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. Further, all rights linked to ideas, inventions and patents generated during the MoU shall remain the common intellectual property of the Parties. The Parties shall not pass on or give usage rights of such property to any third party without the consent of the other party.

8. Dispute Settlement:

In the event of any dispute or difference arising under this Agreement, the Parties shall try to discuss and arrive at an amicable resolution thereof. If the Parties fail to arrive at an amicable resolution within (thirty) 30 days of the dispute having arisen, the matter shall be referred to arbitration by a single arbitrator appointed pursuant to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitral proceedings shall be held in Guwahati and the language of arbitration shall be English. The Parties agree that the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the Parties. The arbitration tribunal shall also decide on the costs of the arbitration procedure.

9. Liability:

Except for loss or damages caused through gross negligence or intent, the Parties shall have no liability to each other hereunder.

10. Force Majeure:

Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to eventualities like floods, earthquakes, strikes, bandhs, lockouts, epidemics, riots and

communications, etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation or cessation of such events, the party affected thereby shall give notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond four months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

11. Legal Relationship:

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to create any legal relationship between the parties.

12. Coming into Force, Amendment and Termination:

This MoU shall come into force from the date of its signature and shall remain valid for a period of 5 years. This MoU may be modified, renewed or extended with the mutual written consent of the Parties. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving six (6) months' notice in writing to the other party.






