Teaching Learning Centre has been conducting Refresher Courses and other training Programs for teachers of higher education as per PMMMNMTT mandate since 2016. Keeping in view the norms regarding COVID19 Pandemic, the proposed Refresher Course will be conducted in online mode. 

About the Workshop

The workshop is for any researchers, professors, academicians interested in writing research papers, publishing their research papers in reputed journals and advancing their career objective of this workshop is to give an introduction to basic issues of writing and organ objective of this workshop is to give an introduction to basic issues of writing and organizing scientific papers as well as on the process of getting a research paper published in a journal or in conference proceedings. The technical session will outline in detail the structural parts of a typical scientific paper including title, abstract, body, discussion and references. Moreover, this webinar series will focus on how to write a research paper and review paper, how to write a journal abstract and the tips for getting accepted in reputed journals, tips for writing the journal articles to get published in SCOPUS, Web of Science, UGC CARE list journals, the process of publishing in an academic journal and research methodology and the selection of realishisting their research work, structure of a lournal parec, citations, netagisting and the publishing their research work, structure of a Journal paper, citations, plagiarism and the process of calculating impact factor. Specially, this workshop will present a synthesis of guidelines found in literature about structuring and writing scientific papers. It will take an interdisciplinary/multidisciplinary stance by giving examples from technology-enhanced learning research and borrowing from literature in social, natural and computing sciences. It is expected that the participants will explore about how to choose the area of research interest, learn a complete research paper outline/format, collect literature from various bibliographical sources, communicate manuscript to the journal, and reply to reviewers comment, acknowledge couple of ethical values and avoiding plagiarism. Overall, the participants will learn the dynamics of scientific writings and publication in reputed journals.
