Moreover, this webinar series will focus on how to write a research paper and review paper, how to write a journal abstract and the tips for getting accepted in reputed journals, tips for writing the journal articles to get published in SCOPUS, Web of Science, UGC CARE list journals, the process of publishing in an academic journal and research methodology and the selection of publishing their research work, structure of a Journal paper, citations, plagiarism and the process of calculating impact factor. Specially, this workshop will present a synthesis of guidelines found in literature about structuring and writing scientific papers. It will take an interdisciplinary/multidisciplinary stance by giving examples from technology-enhanced learning research and borrowing from literature in social, natural and computing sciences. It is expected that the participants will explore about how to choose the area of research interest, learn a complete research paper outline/format, collect literature from various bibliographical sources, communicate manuscript to the journal, and reply to reviewers comment, acknowledge couple of ethical values and avoiding plagiarism. Overall, the participants will learn the dynamics of scientific writings and publication in reputed journals.
