About the College

Gargaon College, established on 7th September 1959 is one of the oldest and illustrious institutions of higher education in Assam. With a commitment to achieve excellence in higher education, the college has been working relentlessly for the development of the learner as well as the furtherance of social good. Dr Harendra Nath Phukan was the founder Principal of the college. The college came under the deficit-grants-in-aid system of Government of Assam in the year 1966 and is included under section 12 (B) and 2 (f) of UGC Act 1956 under the affiliation of Dibrugarh University. Subsequently, the college was provincialized in 1966 under the leadership of Tanu Konger, the first permanent Principal of this institution.

Located in the heart of Gargaon, the college is fourteen kilometers to the east of Sivasagar town and well connected by road and rail. The college has a vast green campus with about 33 numbers of bird diversity, 32 numbers of fish diversity and more than two hundred varieties of medicinal plants. The college has also initiated an organic garden, vermicompost project, plastic bottle bank among other endeavors for promoting sustainable agricultural practices in the campus. From the historical standpoint, Gargaon was the capital of the Ahom Kingdom from 1539 A.D. to 1695 A.D. The Kareng Ghar, the seven storied Royal Palace of the Ahom kings, is situated within Gargaon, resonating the glory of the Ahom Kings and Assamese people of yore.

Gargaon College has been persistently trying to improvise its knowledge delivery mechanism and infrastructure. The College was assessed and accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) for the first time in the year 2004. It was re-accredited for the second time in the year 2010. Most recently NAAC re-accredited the college with 'B-Grade' in the year 2019.

The College currently provides both Higher Secondary and Three-Year Bachelor's Degree (Major and Pass Course) courses to more than two thousand students every academic year. The College has three faculties – Arts, Science and Commerce spread over seventeen departments.

Besides its regular courses, the college also provides a one year Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA). It has also taken the initiative to introduce a select list of Add On courses and vocational programmes along with B.Ed course in keeping with the objectives of NEP, 2020. Through various programmes conducted by its career counseling and guidance cell, the college has been able to guide and orient several meritorious and economically weak students towards successful careers in civil services and other competitive examinations.



About the College

Significantly, students of the college have excelled in academics as well as extracurricular activities. During 2020–21, the pass percentage of the students was 95%. The college has earned the distinction of earning the second best team title for two consecutive years at the Dibrugarh University Inter College Youth Festival hosted by Gargaon College in 2020 and in 2022 at D.K.D College respectively.

In tune with its mission of delivering quality education and making the teaching learning process more effective, the College has created Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Assam Agricultural University, Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University and also with international institutions and organizations of repute. An e-learning platform named as E-Siksha has also been launched by the college which incorporates educational videos based on the curricula prepared by the faculty and facilitates online learning and access of its resources by the students anytime and from anywhere. Moreover, the college has its own YouTube channel which broadcasts special lectures and talks on relevant issues from time to time. Besides, several faculty members have their own YouTube channels delivering well-designed learning content for the benefit of the student fraternity. The college tries to provide impetus to research activity among students and teachers. Along with several student projects, the faculty members are engaged in both major and minor research projects sponsored by ICSSR, ICHR etc.

The college is committed towards growing into a centre of excellence and sustaining its historical legacy to be the best by catering to all the needs of the learners and is well-equipped to face the emerging needs and challenges of the times. Considering the social and economic backwardness of the region, Gargaon College has taken the onus of enlightening and edifying the minds of its students so that they can become exemplary citizens and contribute to the betterment of the society.









2. Career Counselling Programme

Students are the future hopes of a country. It is very essential to provide the right career options at the college level. Moreover, competitive examinations formulate the foundation for various civil services and also function as a necessary groundwork to sign up for various higher studies courses in universities or other reputed institutes situated across the globe. Gargaon College has a Career Guidance Cell to provide information to the students who plan to pursue higher studies or are keen on to qualify for any competitive examinations. Career counselors from the Career Guidance Cell guide the students and support them with the right directives during their journey to be eligible for any competitive exam and enter higher studies. In addition, this cell regularly organizes Career related workshops, webinars, popular talks, special training programs for civil service examinations, TET, PG Entrance Tests for different universities, etc. inviting Resource Persons from various fields. Further, mentors discuss and advise the mentees on a one-to-one basis regarding their career-related queries. Around 1886 students benefited from competitive examinations training and 5,297 students were provided training and development through career counselling programs during the period 1st July 2019-28th March, 2024.











3. GYAN-YATRA

Gargaon College situated within the historic precincts of Gargaon, the erstwhile capital of the Ahom kingdom, is one of the foremost institutions of repute in Upper Assam. The college has been making consistent efforts to impart quality education as well as to work for the furtherance of the community. It has the requisite infrastructure and qualified faculty equipped with relevant expertise in their chosen field, both of which can be harnessed to uplift students from the economically weaker sections of society. With such an aim in mind, a project named 'Gyanyatra' has been undertaken under the aegis of IQAC, Gargaon College, in 2023. Under this initiative, the college has created a platform to render support to schools and underprivileged students in the sphere of education and allied areas. It was observed that the use of online mode of education which was kick-started during the pandemic couldn't be accessed by underprivileged students of remote areas mainly due to their economic constraints. In order to remove such disparities, Project Gyanyatra has taken the onus of reaching out to such students and offering necessary academic support. Along with imparting lessons related to the school/college curriculum, the project aims to impart training for career prospects, life skills, communication skills, health and well-being among others. Under this programme, the college has adopted several schools and has carried out classes, plantation drives etc. This programme shall benefit students up to the higher secondary level. This project has been made successful with the help of the good-will and voluntary support of teachers, students, alumni and all well-wishers. It is hoped that in this project, the needy students and schools shall not be the only ones to be assisted but every individual volunteering for the programme shall be enriched in some way by this noble initiative. 



6. Yuva Tourism Club
