Overview

- ACADEMIC WELFARE: The College conducts FDPs, Workshops, Laboratory training programmes etc. as well as makes arrangements for availing permission to attend different career development programmes for its teaching and non-teaching staff.
- INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES: The college has ICT enabled classrooms, seminar and conference rooms, a library, Laboratories, Gymnasium, Indoor Stadium etc.
- FINANCIAL SUPPORT: Sanchay Aru Rindan Somobai Samiti (SARSS) extends financial support to its members by providing loans at reasonable rates of interest. The institution is a government-aided college. Its employees get the benefit of pensions like the Employees Provident Fund (EPF) and the New Pension System. Other financial supports are also provided by the college for welfare of its teaching and non-teaching staff.
- **HEALTH AWARENESS & SANITATION:** Health camps, awareness programmes etc. are conducted by the College. It has its Yoga Centre that conducts various workshops for the health and well-being of the college fraternity as well as the neighbouring community.
- **RECOGNITION AND AWARDS:** The college felicitates the Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff for their outstanding contributions in different fields.

- The college has a Research Cell which motivates and supports the college fraternity to carry out research in areas of importance and motivates the teaching staff to apply for various research projects under different sponsoring agencies.
- The College has a Publication Cell established to promote creativity and original writing among the faculty members.
- The college has well equipped library with a collection of more than 32000 books. In addition to this, there are more than 10000 books available in different Departmental Libraries of the college. A good number of national and international magazines, periodicals, journals, and newspapers are also subscribed by the library. The Library webpage is also linked with a good number of open access e-journals and e-books, e.g.-DOAJ, OTAD, Springer open access e-journal, e-books, Intech open access books, etc. The library is subscribed to the UGC N-List consortia. It provides 6293 (+) e-journals (full text) and 195,000 (+) e-books. The library is digitalized and it gives access to various e-resources.



FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- To cater to the financial needs of the staff the Sanchay Aru Rindan Somobai Samiti (SARSS) is managed by the staff with the approval of the management. 
